Wooden Box Cube.Projects

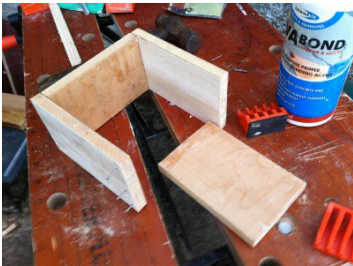

Wooden Box Cube.

Storage,we all need storage,and always somewhere to put things.

Nobody likes clutter,so here is the start of a Wooden Box Cube,and the beauty of Cube Boxes,you can build them any size and paint them in all kinds of colour and finishing touches.

Lets get started,their will be more picture's as i do each step to finish it.



The first thing i did was to make sure i used some nice squared timber,and not to thick.

I cut 4 Piece's and trimmed any rough edges,and sanded them down.

Next i used some Pva Bonding Glue,and prepared some small panel pins,by hammering them half way into the timber,best to do this on a solid surface.

From the photo you can see the box is taking shape.



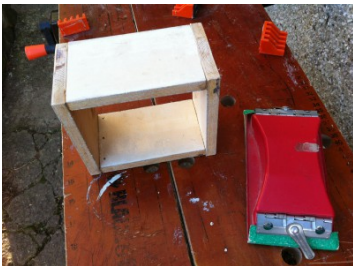
All squared off,and set to dry.



Looking Good.



Next step below, was to sand.



Abit more sanding needed, it took about 20 mins to sand the whole box.



Now for some Painting, i did this with an undercoat tin of paint, that was going to be thrown away by a neighbour.





Time to leave the box to dry, and come back another day.

I have a few other projects on the go, they will appear in the next day or two.

For now it's time for a cupa.

I did some more sanding after filling in indentations after hole punching the nails.

The above picture is also showing a custom Clamp, I needed this with an earlier project.



After sanding I started painting the actual colour I want, I decided on Sage Green, a nice pastel colour.

After several Coats of Paint, this is the result.

I am very happy with the soft look with the colour Sage Green.

You can put anything in or on the Box Cube, I chose as a demonstration, some Nature artifacts.



Very simple way of hanging the Wooden Box Cube.

I will be making some more with different colours, to compliment each other, and spread Colour through the house.
