I used some Halving Joints to make it foldable,and painted followed by some sanding,and sealed with Danish oil.

The colour red with sanding has enhanced the feel of the wood,and gives it a nice warm glow.

This is an easy to carry desktop storage, you can use it for your mouse or pop your pens, pencils or what ever you have on your workstation or desk.

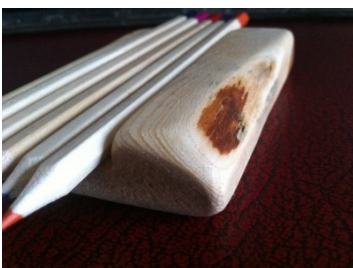
Easy to transport around and carry in you pocket for popping your mobile phone on as well.
